Nestled within the wooded banks of the Arboretum District's Stone Lake, the Roaring Fork delivers bold American cooking united with the comfort of its surroundings. Panoramic waterfront views, operable window walls and extensive glass fully invite the outside environment into the restaurant. Set upon piers the restaurant's floor is a platform situated within the canopy of Live Oak and Cedar trees. The trees are in concert with the restaurant's vibe interacting and embellishing each patron's dining experience. Like a favorite porch the plan harmonizes with its indigenous neighbors, the trees, cantilevering over a moonlit lake offering a truly pastoral atmosphere. The restaurant presents itself as a well-kept secret. The open, contemporary interior does not reveal itself until one approaches the front door. Behind the timeless hand crafted masonry walls lies the glow of a wood fire, the scent of rotisserie exploding into a composition of steel, glass and warm wood detailing. The interior palette is one of rich wood floors and clean lines of exposed mill finished steel. The tables sit upon exotic Ipe wood flooring extending through the exterior glass becoming the patio deck. Overhead, exposed steel trusses and beams are juxtaposed with stained wood planked ceilings setting the scene for bold American comfort food patrons of the Fork have come to expect.
